Garrison Brewing Honoured Four Times at 2011 Canadian Brewing Awards!

HALIFAX, NS – Sept. 9, 2011 – Last Friday, Garrison Vice-President Mark Obermaier and Brewmaster Daniel Girard attended the 9th annual Canadian Brewing Awards in Toronto and left with four medals. This was the largest competition to date with hundreds of beers submitted from every province (except Manitoba) in 37 categories.

Garrison received the following awards:

- **GOLD** for Grand Baltic Porter
- **BRONZE** for Ol' Fog Burner Barleywine
- **BRONZE** for Ol' Fog Burner Barrel-aged
- **BRONZE** for NiT WiT Belgian-Style Wheat

This is the second gold-medal win at the CBA's for Grand Baltic Porter. It was also gratifying to win a medal for the region's first barrel-aged brew and for NiT WiT, the winning recipe in Garrison's "Ultimate Brew-off" homebrew challenge.

As a whole, this region was well-represented with Gahan House and Acadie Broue winning medals and Picaroons of New Brunswick winning Canadian Brewery of the Year.
