**Job Description:** Based in Halifax and reporting to the Brew Master, you are responsible for all aspects of keg and package beer distribution within the HRM. This will include restaurant and bar customers, external events and occasionally, direct to private customers. You will also support the greater company requirements by transferring product and materials between locations and running external errands. While this is primarily a Monday to Friday role, some weekends or evenings may be required during peak times.

### **Responsibilities:**

- planning and carrying out all keg deliveries including courier shipments
- planning and carrying out all local licensee packaged product deliveries
- creating customer invoices and accurately inputting information into our inventory control management program (EKOS)
- processing and collecting customer payments as required
- conducting initial assessment/trouble-shooting of draught issues at licensees, and ensuring the necessary steps are taken to resolve issues quickly
- conducting general brewery/warehouse duties such as keg filling, moving materials as required, company errands as needed
- advising the General Manager and Brew Master of any maintenance issues with delivery vehicle(s)
- working with the Production and Sales Team to ensure smooth and continuous beer distribution
