- Perform necessary microbiological testing, recording & reporting.
- Perform necessary quality assurance testing (e.g., daily beer checks, measurements on equipment and on packaging materials, beer pH, gravities, carbon dioxide & dissolved oxygen, assessment on packaged and non-packaged beer quality).
- Monitoring fermentation process when on site.
- Input document information in EKOS.
- Assist in the creation and development of SOP's and testing methods.
- Maintain a clean and orderly lab, ensuring a sufficient inventory of consumables and ordering as necessary.
- Participate in beer quality assessment sensory panel as required.
- working with chemicals and other workplace hazards in a safe and vigilant manner.
- Assisting with cleaning brewery tanks and production areas, conducting beer transfers, and setting up, cleaning, and sanitizing equipment.
